Happy Winter! We hope you all had a fabulous holiday filled with family, friends, love, and laughter. This winter has brought about many changes to the Campground. We are excited to share these changes with you!

Important Updates:

NEW PROPANE FILLING STATION

Part of the service with our propane supplier allowed us to acquire a brand new tank as a routine service upgrade. Since a new tank was coming we decided to relocate the filling station. The new location isn't far from the original but now eases the filling of motorhomes and no longer requires them to back into the fill station. Think of it as a pull through service now. Also, during filling of motorhomes we no longer block access to the dumpsters. If all goes well the entire area around the gate will be remodeled to accommodate more parking for our campers in the park.

ELECTRICAL UPGRADES

You will also notice several new utility power poles throughout the park. These new poles have been installed by National Grid and with the intent to break apart some of the electrical usage from the users at the pond from the users at the top of the hill. What does this mean? It means more consistent electricity to all users and less popping of breakers during heavy traffic times. The end goal will be 50 amp service to the entire park, but that will take time. This is one step to getting us closer to that goal.

FRESH WATER (DRINKING WATER) TANK UPGRADE

We are currently in the beginning steps of replacing our fresh water tank that supplies all the drinking water to the park. This will require some demolition to the upper bathrooms to pull the old tank out and will allow a more state of the art (and easier to repair) system to be installed. How does this affect you? The upgrade will supply more consistent water pressure to the park, users should notice a fresher water taste, and the new system will require less time by our staff to maintain. This project is a huge undertaking but we are hoping to have it wrapped up by the end of February.
